



OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a project in Pinal County to improve pavement, add a right-hand turn lane on State Route 87 at Kenworthy Road and add a left-hand turn lane on SR 287 at Christensen Road.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Adding a right-hand turn lane on northbound SR 87
- ▶ Adding a left-hand turn lane on eastbound SR 287
- ▶ Repairing asphalt
- ▶ Installing a chip seal over the asphalt
- ▶ Completing new pavement markings

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled to begin in late fall 2023 and is expected to take five months to complete.
