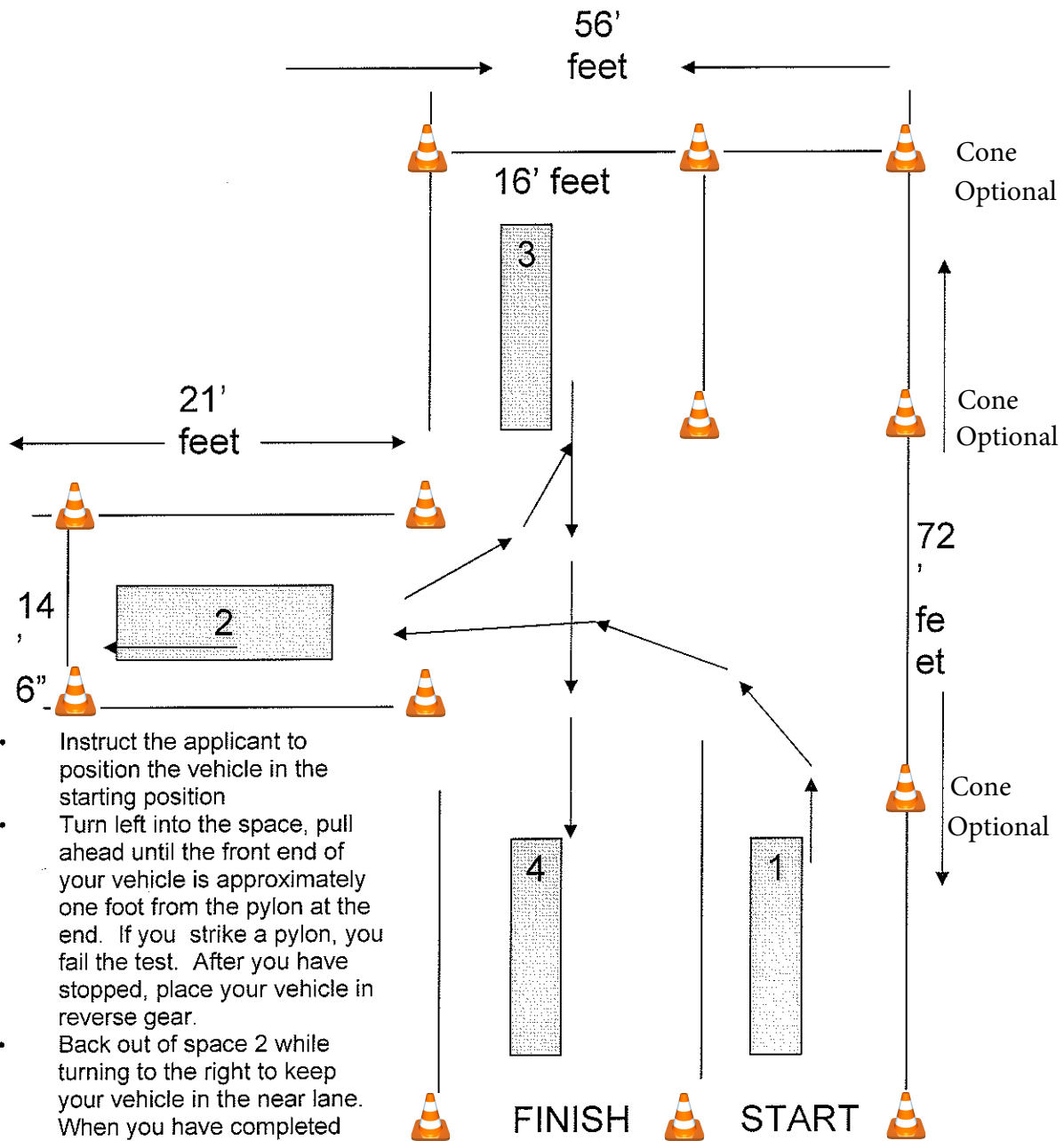


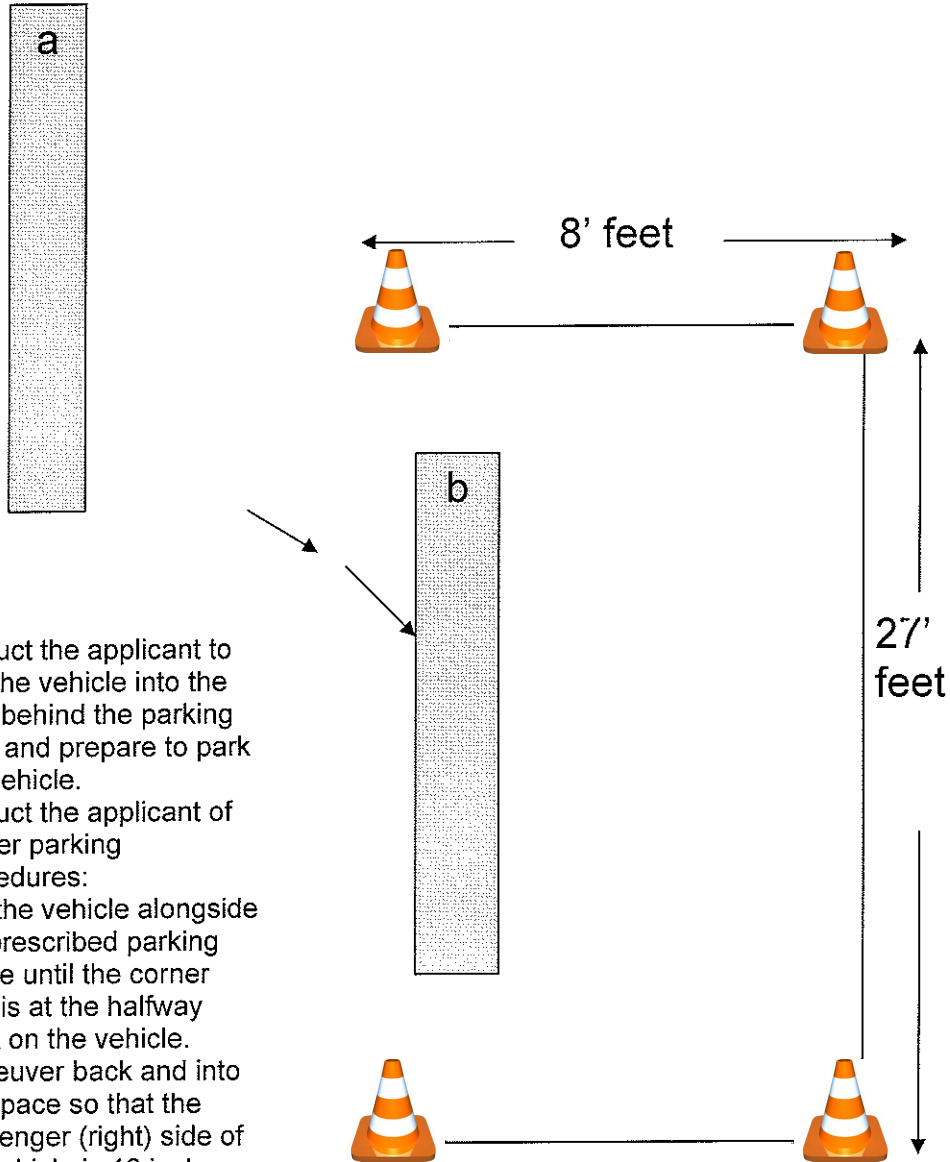
Sample Three Point Turn



- Instruct the applicant to position the vehicle in the starting position
- Turn left into the space, pull ahead until the front end of your vehicle is approximately one foot from the pylon at the end. If you strike a pylon, you fail the test. After you have stopped, place your vehicle in reverse gear.
- Back out of space 2 while turning to the right to keep your vehicle in the near lane. When you have completed your backing, turn into the next lane, stop, shift into forward gear and drive forward.
- Stop the vehicle when you are even with your original starting point.

Note: The PDS Program recommend at least 10 cones be utilized for this manuver

Sample Parallel Parking



- Instruct the applicant to pull the vehicle into the lane behind the parking area and prepare to park the vehicle.
- Instruct the applicant of proper parking procedures:
- Pull the vehicle alongside the prescribed parking space until the corner post is at the halfway point on the vehicle.
- Maneuver back and into the space so that the passenger (right) side of the vehicle is 18 inches or less from the edge of the curbing of the parking space.
- All four tires must be in the parking space.
