



# SR 87 (Duthie-Martin Highway)

from New Four Peaks Road North  
Roadway Widening and Erosion Control Project

As part of the Regional Transportation Plan, roadway improvements are planned for SR 87 (Duthie-Martin Highway) from milepost 204.3 to milepost 213.0 north of the new Four Peaks Road intersection.

The roadway improvements will be designed to reduce accidents and increase SR 87's functionality. To prepare for construction, the Arizona Department of Transportation is completing a construction design plan.

The design plan covers two segments of the roadway north of the recently completed SR 87-Bush Highway interchange.

- The southbound lanes from milepost 204.3 to milepost 206.7 will be reconstructed, and the roadway will be widened from milepost 206.7 to milepost 209.7. A new climbing lane will also be added.
- The second segment, from milepost 211.8 to milepost 213.0, is an erosion-control project.

Once the design is completed, it is expected that construction of the erosion-control portion of the project will occur from spring to fall 2010. The reconstruction and widening portion of the project is expected to occur between fall 2010 and spring 2011.
