

# Arizona's Telephone System



## Priority Message

Caller cannot bypass Priority Message when active (i.e., AMBER Alert)



## «\*» Touch Tone Mode

Enter/Exit Touch Tone Mode by pressing the Star Key



## «1» ROADS...

Request information on specific ADOT roadway (like I-10), selected named roadways (like Papago), or Regional Reports (like East Valley)



## «2» TRANSIT...

Information on dozens of transit agencies throughout Arizona, complete with transfer capability to each.



## «3» AIRPORTS...

Request information or transfer to either Phoenix Sky Harbor or Tucson Int'l.



## «4» TOURSIM...

Options include transfer to Arizona Office of Tourism or information/transfer to one of 52 State & National Parks within Arizona



## «5» REGIONAL REPORT...

Seven Regional Reports available; six in Phoenix and one in Tucson.



## «7» SPECIAL EVENT

For events with more than 30,000 daily participants.



## «8» COMMENTS

You may leave a comment for ADOT at any time; all comments are tracked..

The Arizona 511 system permits both Voice Recognition (speak a key word) and Touch Tone (use keypad to enter choices) Modes.

; Voice Commands are shown in BOLD CAPS

; Clicking a box that contains ellipsis ("...") will bring you to another menu with more information on the scheduled item.

; The Touch Tone key/command is shown within the chevrons (« »)
