



SR 377 Pavement Rehabilitation

SR 277 - FOREST SERVICE BOUNDARY

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is initiating a pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 377 between Heber-Overgaard and Holbrook (mileposts 0-6). The purpose of the project is to extend the life of the pavement and create a smooth driving surface. The work will include removing and replacing the surface pavement, restriping the roadway and other related work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- SR 377 will be reduced to one lane only in segments with alternating north- and southbound travel during construction. Drivers will be directed through the work zone by flaggers and a pilot car.
- Restrictions will be in place Mondays - Fridays from 6 a.m. - 6 p.m. during construction.
- Drivers need to be prepared to slow down and stop in the work zone and use caution around construction personnel and equipment while the restrictions are in place.
