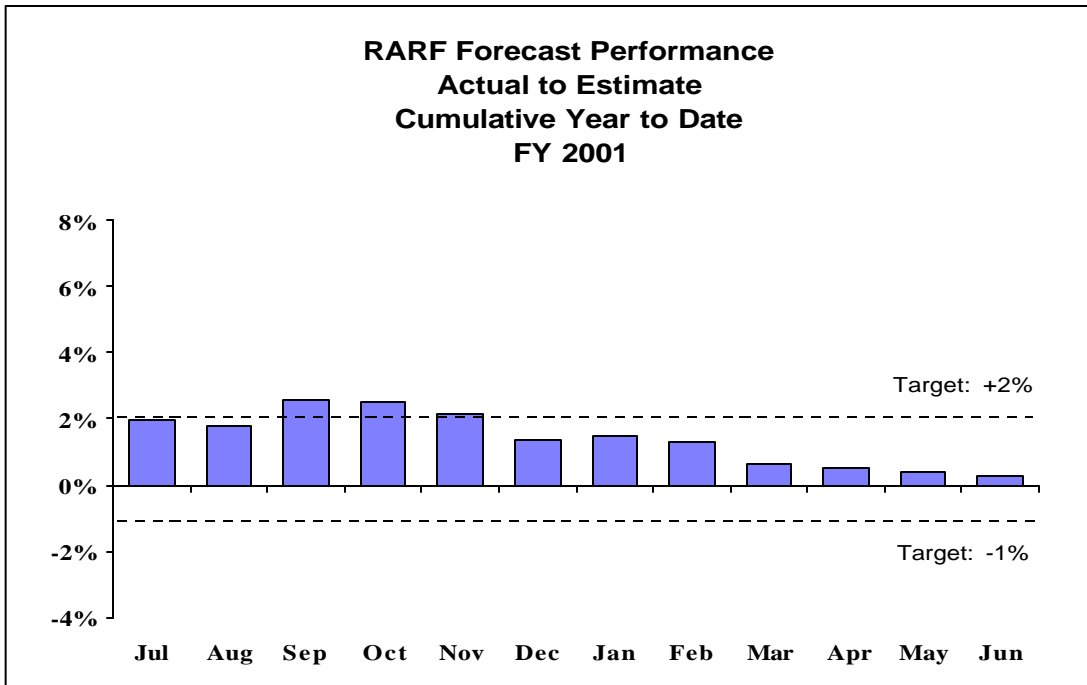

Summary:

FY 2001 RARF collections totaled \$264.7 million, an increase of 6.5 percent over FY 2000 and 0.3 percent above the estimate. Collections for the month of May amounted to \$22.3 million, an increase of 4.6 percent over May 2000. Considering the significant slowdown in the national economy over the past three quarters, RARF revenue categories posted modest gains in FY 2001 with strength across the board. However, there has been a slight softening in RARF collections that may carryover into the first half of FY 2002.

Highlights:

- The **Other and Rental of Real Property** revenue categories posted the strongest gains in FY 2001 with year-over-year increases of 11.4 and 9.2 percent, respectively.
- The **Contracting** revenue category provided the biggest surprise in FY 2001 with an increase of 3.8 percent over FY 2000 and 1.8 percent above the forecast. This sector has benefited from continued strength in the commercial and residential sectors.
