## Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon Steps for Activation

When there is no pedestrian waiting to cross, drivers will see that all indication lights are dark and the pedestrian will see a "DON'T WALK" symbol. A pedestrian who wants to cross the street will need to push the button to cross.

When a pedestrian pushes the button to cross, approaching drivers will see a FLASHING YELLOW for a few seconds indicating that they should reduce speed and be prepared to stop for a pedestrian in the crosswalk. Pedestrians will continue to see a "DON'T WALK" symbol and should wait.

Drivers will see a **STEADY YELLOW**, warning drivers the indication will soon turn to **STEADY RED**. Pedestrians will continue to see the "**DON'T WALK**" symbol and should continue to wait.

Drivers will see a **STEADY RED** light which will require them to STOP at the stop line. At this point, the pedestrian receives a **WALK** indication to cross.

As the pedestrian crosses the street, drivers will see ALTERNATING FLASHING RED lights, indicating that they need to stop. During this period, motorists are required to STOP or remain stopped until pedestrians have finished crossing the street, and then may proceed with caution. Pedestrians will see a flashing countdown which indicates how much time they have to cross the street.

At the end of the flashing countdown indication, drivers will see that all indication lights are dark and the pedestrian will see a "DON'T WALK" symbol. Drivers may continue to proceed through the crosswalk if it is clear and pedestrians waiting to cross will have to push the button to cross.
