The above referenced construction project requires installation of traffic electrical equipment on the above referenced project. The Department's desire to complete the installation of the electrical system in the shortest time possible necessitates the use of Department Furnished Materials (DFM). These items, if purchased by the contractor, generally require a lead-time of eight to twelve weeks from the time the order is released.

The Department believes it is in the public's best interest to require the contractor to install materials furnished by ADOT Traffic Operations. I request that Traffic Operations authorize the issuance of **(State here what you need for the project)** for the above referenced project. Once authorized by Traffic Operations a copy of the change order will be provided to Traffic Operations before the contractor picks up the DFM.

Traffic Operations is authorized to bill the funding construction org and project tracs number for the warehouse inventory cost of those materials provided to the project.
