Subject: Policy Regarding Descriptions for Parcels Requiring an HED

On May 24 an e-mail was sent to all Consultants setting forth a new policy governing descriptions of Parcels which require a Highway Easement Deed (BLM, National Forest, National Parks).

The BLM has provided further clarification as to how they will require such Parcels to be described. The clarification states that Quarter/quarter Sections located in the same Quarter Section can be combined using Half-sections. Rather than try to explain this with more words, I have attached a drawing in pdf format which shows several examples. Each example shows a highway traversing portions of a Section of land; beside each example is the way that the description should appear in the Description field of the Ownership Record Sheet.

Note that the elements of each description should GENERALLY proceed with the direction of the stationing of the highway.
