



Buyer and seller should do this after agreeing to transfer the vehicle title. If there are still negotiations or other options being considered, it's too soon to start this process.

Both buyer and seller will need an AZ MVD Now account for an E-Title Transfer. Register at AZMVDNow.gov.

Log in to AZ MVD Now

See if your vehicle qualifies by checking AZ MVD Now .

Carefully review and complete the vehicle information section.

You will be notified when the buyer approves the vehicle information. You can now release ownership and transfer title.

A sold notice will automatically be placed on the vehicle you transferred.

Remove your plate from your vehicle.

Visit AZMVDNow.gov to request your plate refund, if applicable.

Log in to AZ MVD Now

2
Get an E-Title Buyer Code and provide it to the seller to ensure confidentiality during this process.

3
You will be notified to review and approve the information from the seller. This indicates your agreement to proceed with the transfer.

4
You will be notified that the ownership is released. You must title and register your new vehicle to finalize the transfer.

5
Print your temporary registration and license plate.

Keep the registration in your vehicle and display the plate so it's visible.

Watch for your physical plate, registration and tab arriving in the mail.
