Description:	<p>The Department and the Overdimensional Permit Council, in coordination with a broad coalition of public and private transportation stakeholder groups, is updating Arizona's oversize and overweight envelope and special permit rules to provide additional regulatory relief for industry partners and ensure effectiveness in achieving statutory objectives under A.R.S. Title 28, Chapter 3, Articles 18 and 19.</p> <p>Updates to the rules include consolidating permit types, eliminating permits rendered unnecessary by the consolidation process, updating statutory references, and codifying the Department's new online procedures for permit application and issuance. Rule amendments also include technical and clarifying changes requested by industry representatives, and approved by the Department, after publication of the current rules made by final rulemaking at 19 A.A.R. 2486, August 16, 2013.</p> <p>The Department and the Overdimensional Permit Council will be publishing additional notices to ensure that all interested parties are provided sufficient opportunity to participate in this rulemaking effort.</p>

Description:	Laws 2019, Chapter 268, removed the stipulation that the Public Safety Fee fully fund 110% of the Department of Public Safety's highway patrol budget less any prior unencumbered balance and by adding a provision that ends the collection of the fee beginning from and after June 30, 2021. In anticipation of the forthcoming changes, the Department engages in this exempt rulemaking in order to reestablish the fee structure without the calculation method and to allow for applicable refunds of any Public Safety Fee paid and collected for any registration year that begins on or after July 1, 2021. This new version of the rule continues the current fee structure but sets the currently calculated amount of \$32 as a static amount. In addition, it maintains the previous provisions of when the fee is collected, which vehicle owners or lessees pay the reduced amounts and the fee stipulations with some updates and clarifications to when the fee is collected and a new inclusion of an applicable refund.
