Description:	<p>The Department and the Overdimensional Permit Council, in coordination with a broad coalition of public and private transportation stakeholder groups, is updating Arizona's oversize and overweight envelope and special permit rules to provide additional regulatory relief for industry partners and ensure effectiveness in achieving statutory objectives under A.R.S. Title 28, Chapter 3, Articles 18 and 19.</p> <p>Updates to the rules include consolidating permit types, eliminating permits rendered unnecessary by the consolidation process, updating statutory references, and codifying the Department's new online procedures for permit application and issuance. Rule amendments also include technical and clarifying changes requested by industry representatives, and approved by the Department, after publication of the current rules made by final rulemaking at 19 A.A.R. 2486, August 16, 2013.</p> <p>The Department and the Overdimensional Permit Council will be publishing additional notices to ensure that all interested parties are provided sufficient opportunity to participate in this rulemaking effort.</p>

The Department determined that the rules should be updated and improved for clarity and for a better reflection of the Department's process and needs. The changes include updates and clarification to the definitions, removal of old and inconsistent information, clarification of the evaluation requirements, clarification of the vision standards and requirements, removal of the unnecessary process of conducting medical-related interviews and additional evaluations, and updates to the standards for the motorcycle noise limits and for child restraint systems.
