

- High southbound volumes on Sundays and after holidays








I-17 Study Background

shoulder use










I-17 Study Current Focus

- Near-term focus: Anthem Way to Sunset Point
- Recommended alternatives add capacity, flexibility
- Conduct environmental studies












Recommended Interim Build Alternative: Widening

 Add one lane both directions Anthem Way (MP 229) to Black Canyon City (MP 245)










Recommended Interim Build Alternative: Flex Lanes

- Add two flex lanes Black Canyon City (MP 245) to Sunset Point (MP 252)
- Separated from SB traffic lanes with concrete barrier







How will the flex lanes work?

- NB access near Black Canyon City
- SB access near Sunset Point
- Open to NB or SB traffic, depending on peak
 - NB on Fridays, Saturdays
 - SB on Sundays
 - Other days as needed for holidays, congestion, incidents









How will the flex lanes work?

- Series of gates will control access into flex lanes
- **Controlled entries: Signs will indicate whether**
- the flex lanes are open
- **Crossovers for NB traffic**
- Loops and cameras will enable ADOT to fully
- monitor flex lanes before changing direction of traffic on flex lanes
- No access to Bumble Bee traffic interchange

- Design: Early 2019
- Construction: Scheduled to begin Fiscal Year 2021-22
