



I-17 Anthem Way to Cordes Junction-SR 69

The Arizona Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration are studying improvements to Interstate 17 between the Anthem Way traffic interchange and the State Route 69 traffic interchange near Cordes Junction. The current effort focuses on adding lane capacity between Anthem Way (MP 229) and Sunset Point (MP 252), which could include constructing two new "flex lanes" adjacent to the southbound roadway between Black Canyon City and Sunset Point.

A public meeting about future I-17 improvements has been scheduled for April 3, 2018. Residents, business owners and other stakeholders are encouraged to attend the meeting, learn more about the recommended alternatives and submit comments. Representatives from the ADOT study team will be available to answer questions.

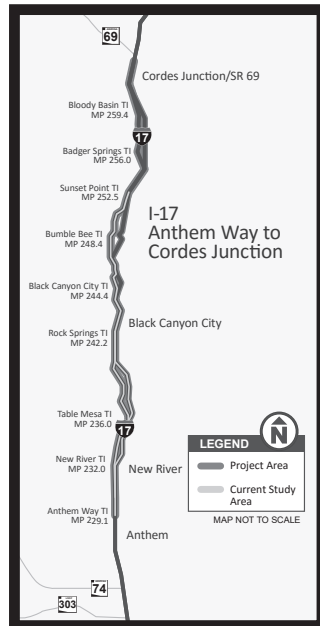
