

Study Area







Study Purpose

- Improve traffic flow
- Meet current and future traffic needs (up to the year 2040) in the project area





Study Overview

- East Frontage Road provides sole access to warehouse district
 - Used by commercial trucks transporting goods along U.S.-Mexico trade routes





Study Overview (cont'd)

- Current East Frontage Road traffic flow
 - Two-way traffic from Ruby Road to Kipper Street
 - One-way traffic (northbound only) from Kipper
 Street to Rio Rico Drive
 - 0.8 mile segment





Study Overview (cont'd)

- All traffic entering warehouse district must use Ruby Road traffic interchange
- Traffic exiting warehouse district may use either Ruby Road or Rio Rico Drive
- Residential traffic and school buses travel between east and west sides of I-19





Study Overview (cont'd)

 Traffic demand during peak periods exceeds capacity at Ruby Road traffic interchange





Study Tasks

- Evaluate existing and projected traffic volumes at:
 - I-19/Ruby Road traffic interchange
 - Along East Frontage Road between Ruby Road and Rio Rico Drive
- Develop, analyze and present alternatives





Study Objectives

- Evaluate cost, environmental and right-of-way impacts of proposed alternatives
- Seek input from community stakeholders





Study Timeline and Plan

- Study began in early 2012
- Final study report anticipated by late 2013
- Stakeholder meetings
 - April 26 and 27, 2012
- Two public meetings
 - May 10, 2012 and early 2013






