I appreciate the invitation regarding the alternative routes for I 10 and SR 210 for the city of Tucson. Here is my input.

No doubt your propose design will relieve traffic congestion and may improve the flow of traffic. However, I think the most important issue here are the losses the community will face by displaced property and business owners. It will bring a major financial and domestic setback to hundreds and perhaps thousands of people. For these reasons, I don't think your plan is a good plan.

I 10 already is designed for straight through traffic with all its appropriate down town exits and frontage roads. I don't believe SR 210 needs to connect with I 10 at all. The only purpose it will serve is have another exit to down town Tucson. All would be a waste of federal and/or tax money.

From my point of view, Tucson doesn't need patch work to solve its traffic problems. I think what needs to be done is for City and County officials work together to fix the existing street roads first and then we can talk about I 10 and SR 210, first things first.

My recommendation is if you really want to improve traffic congestion and flow is to incorporate a loop interstate around the city of Tucson, kind of like the Texas Interstate 610 that surrounds the city of Houston.

Finally, something may be done about the awful mess encountered everyday on I-10 both east from Park Avenue to Valencia, and west from Alvernon to Park Avenue.

Going home, west on I-10, the Alvernon and Palo Verde onramps provide ample opportunity that is rarely passed up by motorists for accidents and constant slow-downs. This can often back traffic up and cause a bottleneck at those two areas.

Going to work at the ASPC-Tucson Complex State prison, the inside lane merging with traffic at Park is a constant problem and of very poor design. Perhaps it worked better 10 years ago, with 500,000 fewer cars, but it's a mess now.
