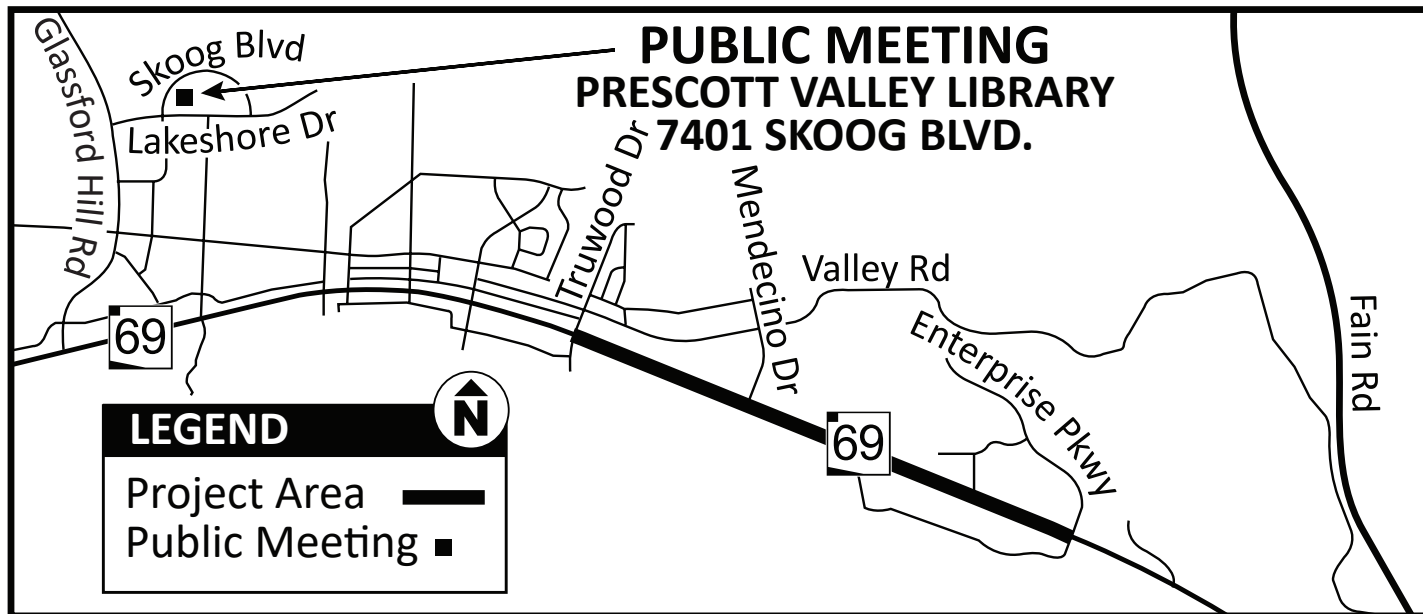


# You're Invited! State Route 69 Public Information Meeting



The Arizona Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is initiating a project to improve transportation safety and traffic operations along the State Route 69 corridor in Prescott Valley. The project includes constructing a raised center median in the existing roadway, preparing for a future Green T intersection at Truwood Drive and installing upgrades for a future signal installation at Mendecino Drive.

ADOT encourages residents, members of the business community and other stakeholders to attend a public meeting to learn more about the project, ask questions and submit comments. Representatives from the ADOT project team will be available to answer questions.
