This bill requires the Department to adopt rules that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Provide information regarding the fleet operation services provided by the Department to eligible agencies that use motor vehicles owned, leased or rented by the state for transporting state officers and employees;</li> <li>2. Inform state officers and employees of their ongoing obligations in regard to the fueling and maintenance services provided by the Department for the state motor vehicle fleet;</li> <li>3. Administer the procurement, surplus, and sale of motor vehicles in the state motor vehicle fleet; and</li> <li>4. Codify the formula used by the Department to recover all costs for fleet operation services provided to each agency.</li> </ol>

<b>Description:</b>	<p>The Department and the Overdimensional Permit Council, in coordination with a broad coalition of public and private transportation stakeholder groups, is updating Arizona's oversize and overweight envelope and special permit rules to provide additional regulatory relief for industry partners and ensure effectiveness in achieving statutory objectives under A.R.S. Title 28, Chapter 3, Articles 18 and 19.</p> <p>Updates to the rules include consolidating permit types, eliminating permits rendered unnecessary by the consolidation process, updating statutory references, and codifying the Department's new online procedures for permit application and issuance.
