


Mule Pass Tunnel Safety Project near Bisbee

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation will complete a safety project to upgrade the lighting system, as well as other roadway improvements in and adjacent to the Mule Pass Tunnel near Bisbee.



PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Upgrading the lighting system in and adjacent to the tunnel.
- ▶ Restriping the roadway to provide a single driving lane in each direction with shoulders on each side of SR 80 through the tunnel.
- Providing a merging area for the Tombstone Canyon on-ramp.
- ▶ Eliminating the passing lane to make way for bicycle lanes.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

▶ Construction began in fall 2022 and will extend into summer 2023.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ Work will occur Mondays through Fridays 10 p.m. to 4 a.m.
- ▶ Motorists should prepare for overnight closures on SR 80 beginning January 2023.
- Signage will alert drivers to closures and alternate routes.
- ▶ A vehicle height restriction will be in place (not applicable to standard passenger vehicles).
