OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a project for pavement rehabilitation on Interstate 10 between Ajo Way and milepost 272 near Rita Road. Construction is scheduled to begin early 2023 and is expected to be completed by the end of 2023.



PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Milling and repaving of the roadway surface
- Bridge repairs
- Guardrail replacement
- Signs and striping

WHAT TO EXPECT

I-10 will be reduced to a single lane at night in various locations throughout the project limits between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. In addition, intermittent overnight ramp restrictions and closures of local streets that pass beneath I-10 within the work zone should also be anticipated during those same hours.
