ADOT'S NONDISCRIMINATION NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC



Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) statutes (23 U.S.C. 148) require states to have an updated, approved Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP). States must complete an SHSP update no later than 5 years from the previous approved version. The goal is to achieve a significant reduction in traffic fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads. Last update was October 2019. This update is due October 2024.

There was \$20.6 Million dollars awarded to prioritize eligible projects in the State-Local Grants program at a rate of 100 percent. These projects are highlighted in yellow. Eliminating the local match ensures that the funding is utilized in the Appropriation's limited timeframe.

To apply for the 100% funding, the State Transportation Board, needs to approve a request of waiver. For the State-Local Grants, there is the State Transportation Board policy that states that there be the 90% State Funding with a 10% Local Airport match. This is in accordance to the State Transportation Policy Chapter 39, Section 1b. It states that the Board may fund eligible projects costs up to the maximum of 90% of eligible costs at Commercial Service, Reliever, and General Aviation Community and Rural airports and a maximum of 95% at General Aviation Basic airports. Once this waiver is approved then the State-Local Grants can be approved with 100% State Funds. This will be presented to the State Transportation Board on December 16, 2022.
