SUBJECT: PRIORITY PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING (PPAC)

Pursuant to the A.R.S. 28-6951(B), the ADOT Director has appointed the members of the Priority Planning Advisory Committee (PPAC) to develop the Five Year Transportation Facilities Construction Program. This meeting is scheduled, pursuant to the above referenced statutes, to review the Five Year Transportation Facilities Construction Program, make changes and schedule new projects into the adopted Five Year Transportation Facilities Construction and take appropriate actions related to the AZ-SMART program and related applications.

ADOT'S NONDISCRIMINATION NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) hereby gives public notice that it is the Agency's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and other related authorities in all of its programs and activities.
