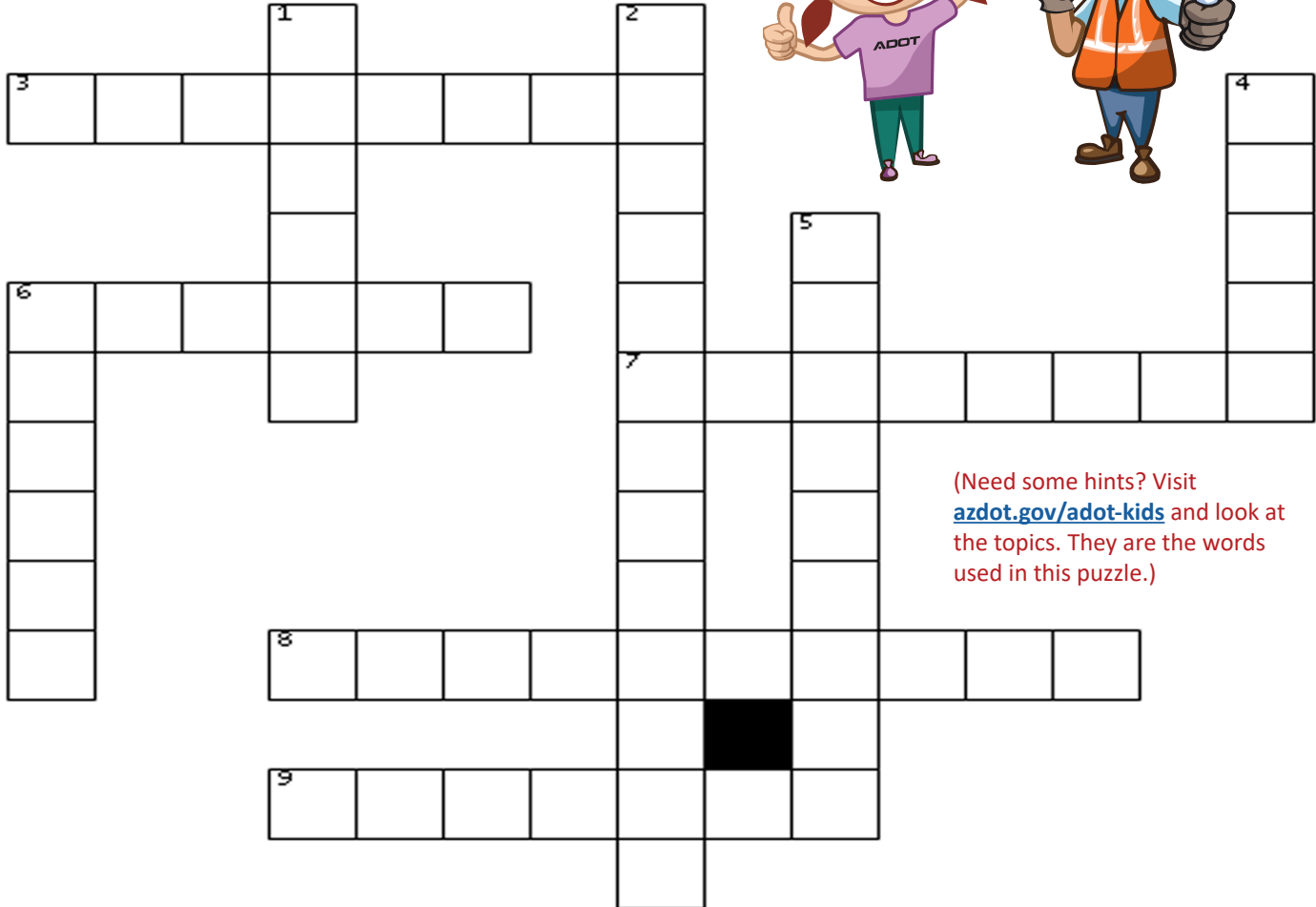


ADOT Kids Criss-Cross Word Puzzle
