Common Mistakes in Preparing Record Drawings

In an effort to streamline the submittal and review of record drawings, below are the common mistakes we are seeing when record drawings are submitted to the Project Resource Office (PRO). Please contact our office if there are any questions or you are unsure about something.

Submittal not being reviewed by the RE (Construction Administrator)



Projects with guardrail and barrier summary sheets



Submittals that have a SWPPP sheet

Overall, the Project Resource Office (PRO) is cooperatively responsible for information management regarding the program's scheduling, resources and budget. This section coordinates with project teams to create critical path schedules for programmed projects. PRO collects, updates and reports on project data and scheduling information (e.g., advertisement dates, project cost, milestone dates, etc.). It is this section's job to monitor project scope and budget changes and to schedule data. Its responsibility to report to management teams the status of projects is essential to proper planning and maintenance of projects in pre-design, design and construction phases.

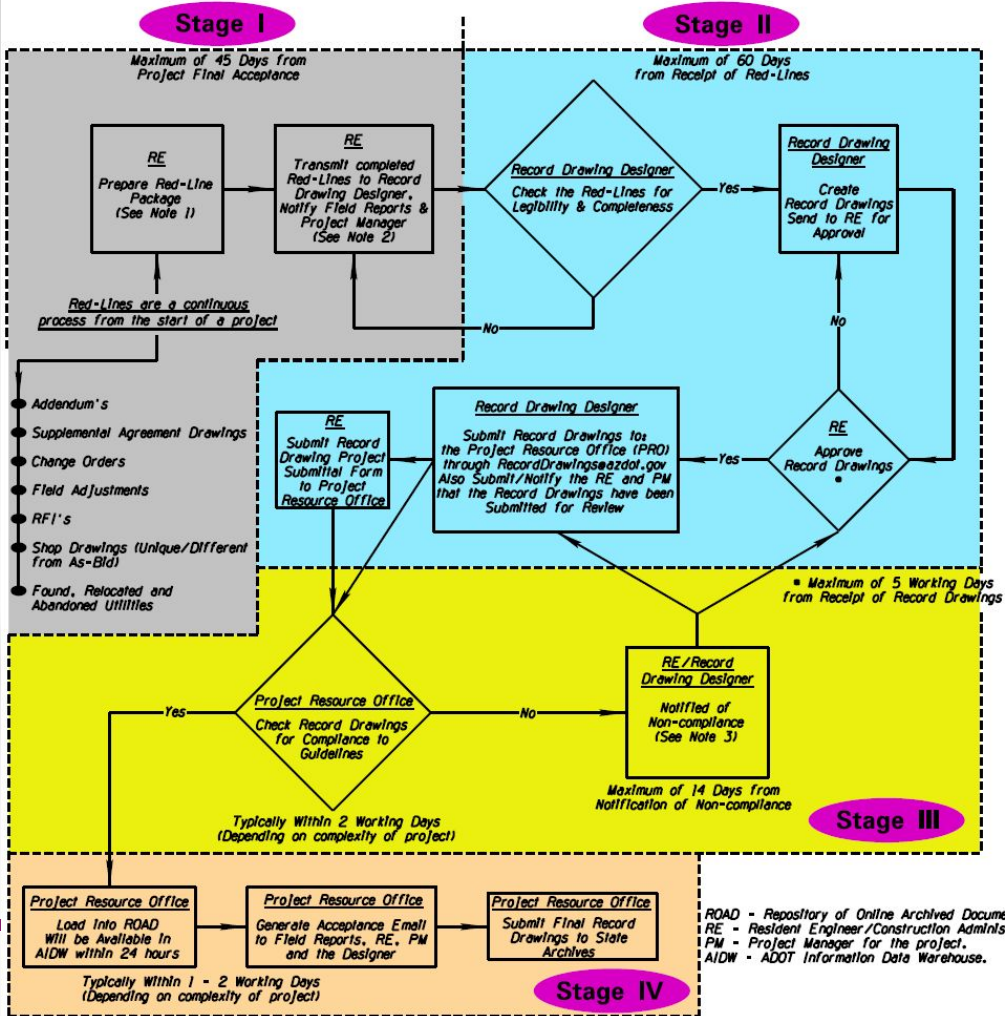

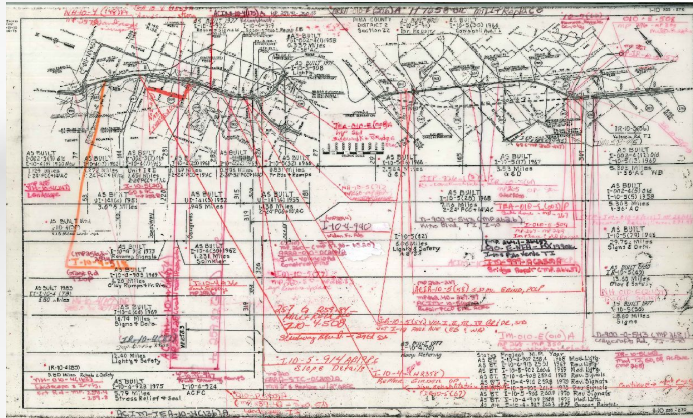

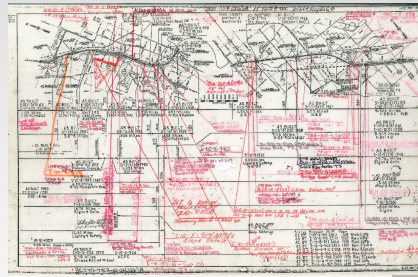

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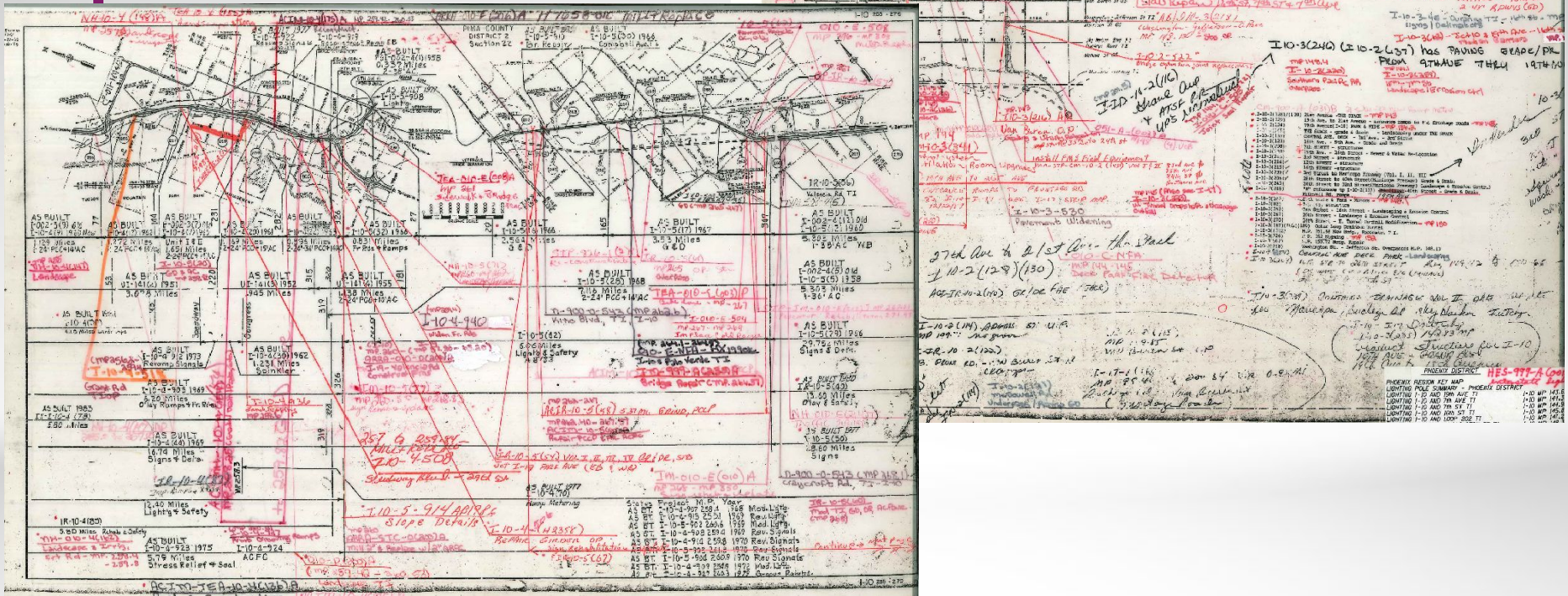

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Public Engineering Records Search

Record Drawings Portal is designed for easy manageability and accessibility of the ADOT Record Drawings. The Project Resource Office (PRO) manages the information available on this site.

The Project Resource Office (PRO) for Development solidifies the final record drawing process. Record drawings demonstrate how the contractor built the project and what changes were made during the construction process. Record drawings are based on the original as bid plans, with field observations, design changes, and red line corrections transcribed onto the final record drawing. Record drawings are approved and finalized by the Resident Engineer, Project Design Engineer, ADOT Construction Group, Field Reports, and appropriate district office. PRO receives the final record drawing documentation and after a thorough review, archives the final file with the Arizona Information Data Warehouse, ADOT Engineering Records, and ADOT Field Reports.

PRO is cooperatively responsible for the information management regarding scheduling, resources, and budget. PRO coordinates with project management teams to create schedules for underway construction projects. PRO collects, updates, and reports on project data and scheduling information such as advertisement dates, project cost, and milestone dates.

What is a project / Tracs number?

The project numbers are utilized by ADOT to give each project a unique identifier. Ex: H798601C

What is a federal number?

The federal number is a unique identifier that signifies the route, milepost or in our historical projects the station and section. Ex: I-8-1(70) or TEA-S95-A(201)T

What does Areawide Selection Mean?

Some projects touch multiple routes, interstates or locations and such will have a 999 for Statewide, 888 for MAG Region and 777 for PAG region.
