ADOT'S NONDISCRIMINATION NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC






Project Background

- ADOT 2006 engineering and environmental study established vision for Loop 303
- Ultimate roadway
 - Four general purpose lanes and one HOV lane in each direction
 - Traffic interchanges
 - Freeway-to-freeway interchange at I-17
- Interim roadway opened in 2011
- In 2021, began design of Loop 303, Lake Pleasant Parkway to I-17 set phasing
 - Phase 1 51st / 43rd Ave interchanges opened Sept. 2023
 - Phase 2 I-17/Loop 303 Interchange
 - Phase 3 Third general purpose lane and 67th Ave bridges



Completed Interchanges - 43rd and 51st Ave






Project Need and Goals
























Environmental Analysis

- Biological, Cultural, Clean Water, Hazardous Materials
- Noise Analysis/Noise Abatement
 - Conducted in accordance with ADOT's Noise Abatement Requirements
 - Performed noise measurements within project limits
 - Predicted noise levels based on future (2050) traffic volumes
 - Evaluated noise mitigation requirements and locations of new noise barriers
 - Residential developments must be permitted for development prior to Date of Public Knowledge
 - Recommended new noise barrier based on future predicted noise levels
- Proposed Noise Barrier Location
 - West side of I-17, south of Dixileta Drive
 - Benefited Property Owners have the right to reject the Proposed Noise Barrier




Environmental Analysis

- Air Quality Analysis
 - In accordance with the Clean Air Act
 - Project is within a Nonattainment Area for PM-10 and Ozone
 - Project is within a Maintenance Area for Carbon Monoxide (CO)
- Additional analyses are being performed to ensure the project remains in conformity with Federal regulations
- Will provide opportunity for public comment on Air Quality Analysis, once completed



Project Timeline and Funding



- Identified in Maricopa Association of Government's Regional Strategic Transportation Infrastructure Investment Plan (RSTIIP)
 - Third general purpose lane, Lake Pleasant Parkway to I-17
 - I-17/Loop 303 Interchange ramps
- Improvements contingent on Voter Approval of Proposition 479 November 2024 Ballot




- Lake Pleasant Parkway, L303 to SR 74 Widening


