



OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization, is planning to widen State Route 69 in the city of Prescott. The project will construct one travel lane in each direction on SR 69 between Prescott Lakes Parkway and Yavpe Connector with a raised center median (mileposts 294-295). In addition, a new raised center median will be constructed between Yavpe Connector and Heather Heights.

The purpose of this project is to increase the capacity of the roadway and improve traffic safety.

Construction is scheduled to begin early July 2024 and take approximately nine months to complete, with a possible winter shutdown based on weather and construction schedule.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

The project includes the following elements:

- ▶ Construct one travel lane in each direction between Prescott Lakes Parkway and Yavpe Connector (mileposts 294-295).
- ▶ Install raised center medians between Prescott Lakes Parkway and Heather Heights.
- ▶ Construct curb and gutter.
- ▶ Install new pipe culverts and storm drains.
- ▶ Install new poles for existing traffic signal.
- ▶ Other related work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ Two travel lanes will be maintained in each direction during daytime hours.
- ▶ One travel lane will be maintained in each direction during overnight hours when construction-related restrictions are in place.
- ▶ Business access will be maintained. However, there may be brief restrictions when/if work takes place in front of driveways or side streets.
- ▶ No restrictions are anticipated during weekends or state holidays.
- ▶ Construction-related noise.
