PRB An Overview




What is PRB?

The Project Review Board (PRB) is the first step in the ADOT Project Change Control System.

The PRB acts on changes to the current Program. The PRB can only make decisions on projects in the current Fiscal Year *.

The next two steps in the Change Control System are the PPAC and the State Transportation Board.







When Does A Project Need To Go To PRB?

> Establish a new project.

Delete a project from the program.

> Change programmed budget.

Defer a project.

> Change project Information.


