

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a project to make drainage improvements on State Route 85 near Gila Bend between milepost 1 and milepost 3. The work consists of making improvements to existing concrete box culverts at five locations.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Replacing existing pavement
- Improvements to existing concrete box culverts at five locations
- Removing existing guardrail and fence
- Place rip rap; a layer of large stones used to protect soil from erosion
- Installation of pavement markings

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled to begin in fall 2024 and is expected to take approximately six months to complete.

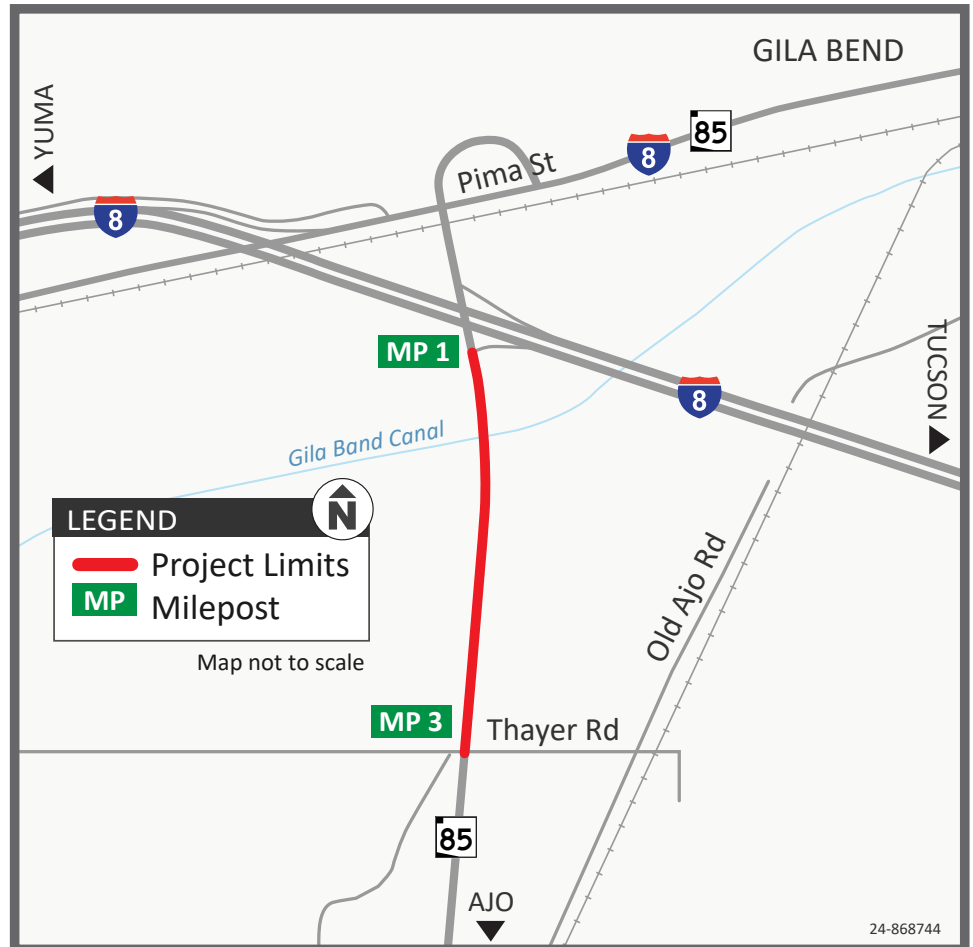
ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.
