

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a project to make drainage improvements on State Route 85 near Gila Bend between mileposts 0.83 and milepost 3.34. The work consists of extending existing concrete box culverts at five locations.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Replacing existing pavement
- Removing existing guardrail and fence
- Place rip rap; a layer of large stones used to protect soil from erosion
- Installation of pavement markings

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The project began September 2024 and is anticipated to be complete spring 2025.

WHAT TO EXPECT

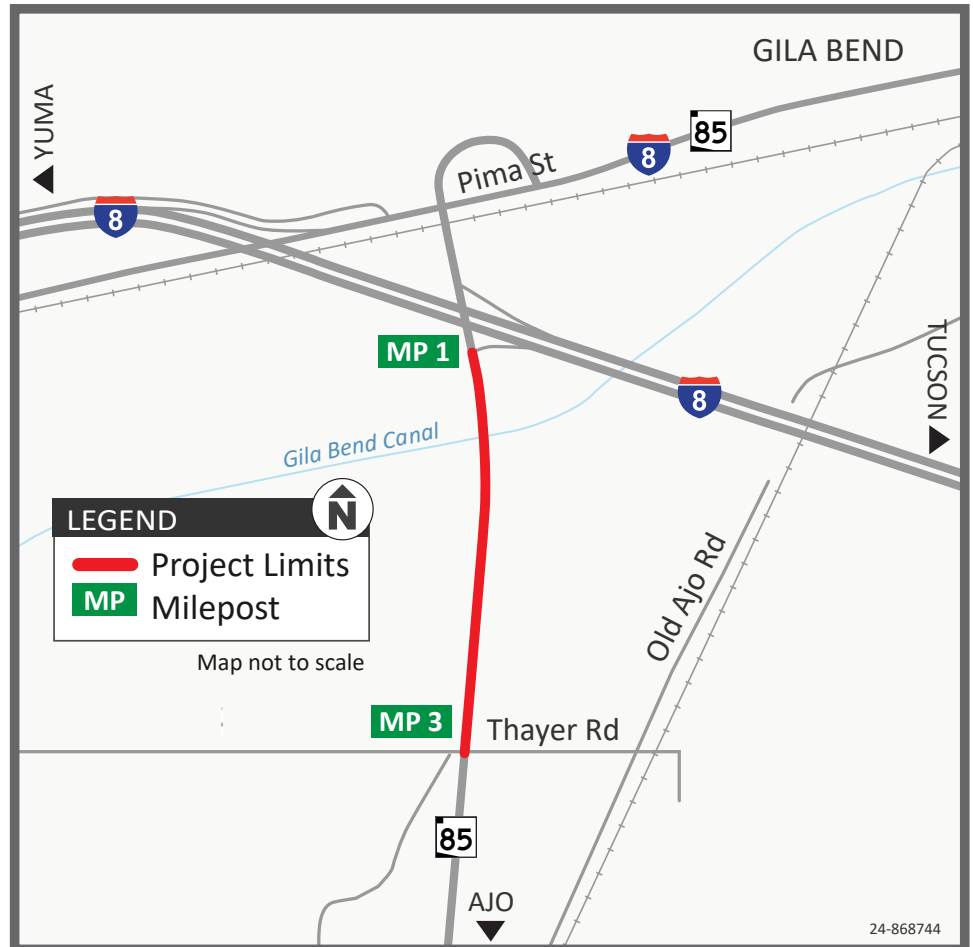
ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.
