



I-19, Irvington Road Traffic Interchange Improvements

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is initiating a project to reconstruct the traffic interchange at Interstate 19 and Irvington Road in Tucson. The purpose of the project is to improve traffic flow at the interchange.

Planned improvements include:

- ▶ Reconstructing the existing diamond interchange and adding a partial cloverleaf ramp at Irvington Road.
- ▶ Widening on-ramps to accommodate future ramp metering.
- ▶ Installing traffic signals, lighting, signage and pavement markings.
- ▶ Constructing pedestrian and bicycle improvements on both sides of Irvington Road.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- ▶ The project is currently in the design phase. The design plans are anticipated to be completed in fall 2025.
- ▶ Construction is anticipated to start early 2026.
