SR 87 at Kleck Road Intersection Improvement Project PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation began a project in February 2025 to construct left-turn lanes on north and southbound State Route 87 at Kleck Road. This project located in the city of Coolidge is anticipated to be completed in summer 2025.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Widening SR 87 in both directions to add left-turn lanes
- Installation of guardrail
- Fog coating
- Other miscellaneous improvements

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction began in February 2025 and is expected to be completed in summer 2025. Schedules are subject to change because of weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Construction is tentatively scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- One lane in each direction is being maintained during construction.
- Flaggers are directing traffic through the intersection during construction.
