

State Route 95, Main Street to Milepost 116 Pavement Rehabilitation

PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is initiating a project to repair the pavement on State Route 95, between Main Street and milepost 116, north of Quartzsite.



PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Milling the existing pavement and replacing it with new pavement
- ▶ Replacing guardrail and guardrail end terminals
- Constructing drainage facilities
- Installing pipe liners
- ▶ Replace bridge barrier transitions
- Replacing pavement markings and other related work

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The project began in December 2024 with completion anticipated summer 2025. Schedules are subject to change because of weather and other unforeseen situations.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Daytime lane restrictions will be required, including pilot and/or flagging operations.
- Drivers are asked to obey posted speed limits, traffic control devices and use caution around construction personnel and equipment.
- ▶ ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.
