



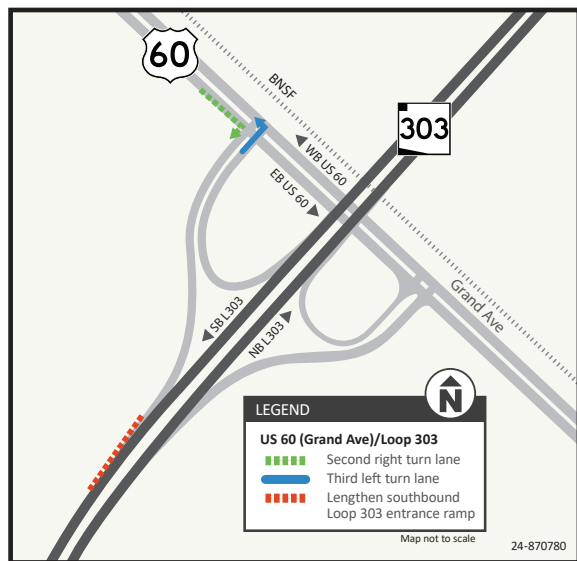
US 60/Loop 303 and US 60/163rd Avenue

Additional Near Term Improvements

PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is currently designing additional near term improvements for US 60/Loop 303 and US 60/163rd Avenue. Funding for these improvements was approved by the Maricopa Association of Governments in October 2024.



US 60/LOOP 303 IMPROVEMENTS

- ▶ Adding a second right turn lane on eastbound US 60 to the southbound Loop 303 on-ramp
- ▶ Adding a third left turn lane from the southbound Loop 303 off-ramp to westbound US 60
- ▶ Lengthening the two-lane portion of the southbound Loop 303 on-ramp

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The project is currently in the design phase. Construction is anticipated to begin in summer 2025 and take approximately six months to complete.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ Work will require lane restrictions and ramp closures and is expected to occur primarily during overnight hours and weekends to minimize traffic impacts.
- ▶ ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project web page.

US 60/163RD AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS

- ▶ Adding a dedicated eastbound right turn lane into the drive between Deer Valley Road and 163rd Avenue and an acceleration lane along eastbound US 60
