I-19 Canoa Ranch Rest Area Sensor Upgrade Project PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is tentatively scheduled to begin a project on the north- and southbound Interstate 19 Canoa Ranch rest areas to install weighin-motion with Automated Tire Pressure Screening and to replace the existing weigh-in-motion system controllers in summer 2025.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Installing weigh-in-motion with Automated Tire Pressure Screening (ATPS)
- Upgrading the existing weigh-in-motion system controllers
- Installing loop sensors and connecting the new loops to the existing cabinet
- Installing a sensor plate next to the existing loops

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction on this project is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2025 and is projected to be completed in winter 2025. Schedules are subject to change because of weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Traffic control devices will guide motorists through the construction area.
- Construction work is tentatively scheduled from 5 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Expect temporary delays as traffic is redirected through a single travel lane.
