

Dove Mountain Boulevard and Moore Road Intersection IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation in collaboration with the town of Marana began work in February 2025 on a project to reconstruct Dove Mountain Boulevard at the Moore Road intersection in Marana.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Installation of traffic signals at all four intersection
- ▶ Replacing existing light poles, controller cabinet and signage
- ▶ Restriping the intersection
- ▶ Constructing new sidewalk ramps
- ▶ Other miscellaneous improvements

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction, which began in February 2025, is expected to be completed in fall 2025. Schedules are subject to change because of weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ One lane of travel in each direction is being maintained during construction.
- ▶ Construction is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- ▶ ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers.

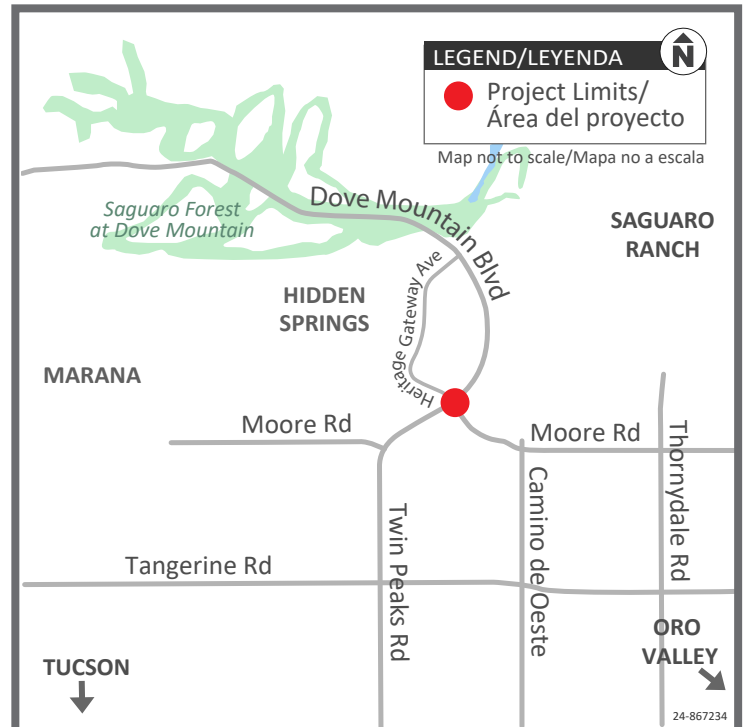
