

Construction Progress: Spring 2025

Construction work is continuing on the I-40/US 93 West Kingman Traffic Interchange project, with progress visible throughout the entire project corridor.

Featured Progress


Girders have been placed on the Clack Canyon Road Bridge. The large, horizontal beams serve as the primary structural support for a bridge deck, which is the part of the bridge motorists drive on. The installation of the bridge deck is the next step in the bridge widening process.





Completed Work:



Current Progress:

- Girders placed on Clack Canyon Road Bridge.
- South of US 93, tall cuts of earth and rocks are being removed to allow for roadway widening.
- Crews are cutting a path through the bluffs north of the existing US 93 approach to tie into I-40.
- Along I-40, sounds walls from Stockton Hill Road heading west are being constructed.
- Bridge work has begun throughout the project area.



Crews are currently installing interior lighting in both the Beale Street and Fort Beale Drive overpass tunnels.



Bridge shafts are being drilled and bridge columns and pier caps are being installed along I-40.

Construction Impacts

- Daytime and nighttime construction activities.
- Occasional single lane closures.
- Construction related noise and lighting (nighttime work).
- During construction, drivers will still be able to exit both US 93 and I-40 at Beale Street to access local businesses, Route 66 and downtown Kingman.

Drivers should be aware of their surroundings when driving through the project area and watch for construction workers near the roadway.



Clack Canyon Road Closure

The closure of Clack Canyon Road between Longview Avenue and Fort Beale Road began in July 2024. The closure is expected to last until mid-2026. Only local residents are permitted on the road.
