Overview

- Runway is distressed and nearing end of useful life
- First major rehabilitation in almost 20 years
- Project will aim to enhance safety, operational efficiency and compliance with FAA regulations.
- This project will not alter the current runway length or width

reopen on August 11**

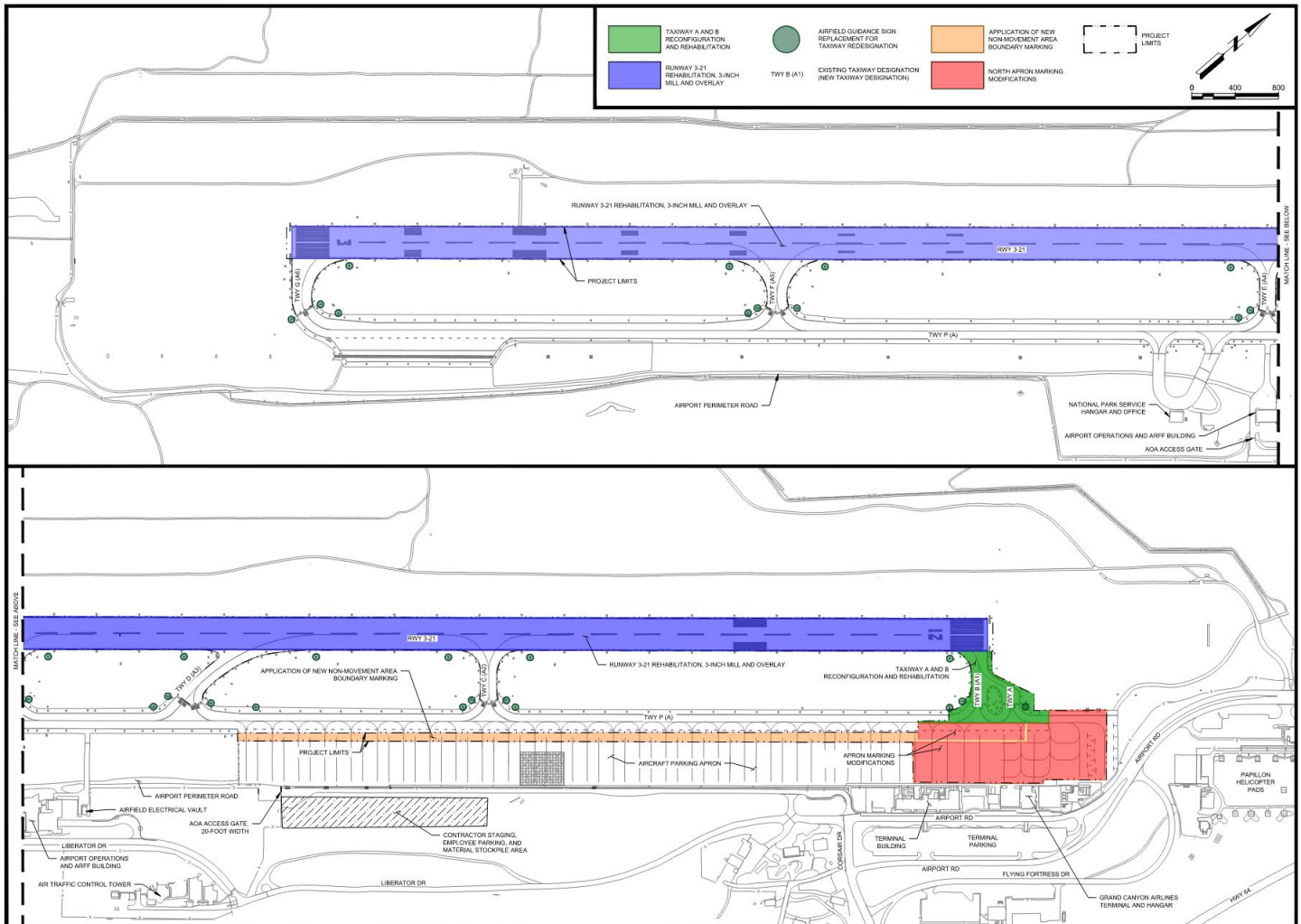

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Project Elements:

- Full width 3-inch mill and overlay of Runway 3-21
- Reconfiguration and Rehabilitation of Taxiway A, and B to address an FAA hotspot.
- Update Taxiway Nomenclature (Signage) to meet FAA standards.
- Marking Modifications on aircraft parking apron near Taxiways A and B, including painting green no-taxi island.
