SR 83: Black Oak Drive to Lower Elgin Road Reconstruction

PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is scheduled to begin a reconstruction and pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 83 from Black Oak Drive (milepost 31) to Lower Elgin Road (milepost 29) in Sonoita in fall 2025.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Removing and replacing the roadway surface
- ▶ Improving erosion control
- ▶ Applying fog coating
- ▶ Installing new signing and pavement marking at the SR 83/Lower Elgin Road intersection
- ▶ Replacing pavement markings and striping
- ▶ Replacing guardrail
- ▶ Constructing drainage upgrades
- ▶ Other miscellaneous improvements

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction on this project is anticipated to begin in fall 2025 and is projected to be completed early 2026. Schedules are subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen situations.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ Flaggers and temporary portable traffic devices will direct traffic through the project area during construction.
- ▶ One lane of travel will be maintained during construction.
- ▶ Construction is tentatively scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.

ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project website.
