#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) released the draft State Management Plan for public review and comment November 5 - 30, 2024.

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requires each state to develop a State Management Plan that describes the policies and procedures to be used in administering federal grant programs that develop new transit systems and improve, maintain and operate existing systems (specifically those within FTA Section 5310, 5311 and 5339).

Updates to the 2024 edition of the State Management Plan include:

- Updates in accordance with new programs
- New section on the use of emergency funding
- New information regarding the use of Consolidated Planning Grants for Transit Planning funding

#### 1.1. Title VI Accommodations

The public outreach effort was conducted in compliance with the Title VI Environmental Justice guidelines approved for the project in the ADOT Public Involvement Plan, on record with ADOT Communications.

### 2. PUBLIC COMMENTING PERIOD

ADOT held a public commenting period on the draft plan November 5-30, 2024. A total of two (2) questions and comments were received from the public during the commenting period. All questions and comments received, as well as the responses, were recorded and included in Appendix C – Public Comments.


