



# State Route 72, Milepost 20 to 30 Pavement Rehabilitation

## PROJECT FACT SHEET

### OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is scheduled to start in the fall of 2025 a project to repair the pavement on State Route 72 between milepost 20 and milepost 30 in Bouse.

### PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Milling and replacing the existing pavement with new pavement
- Replacing guardrail and guardrail end terminals
- Installing new fence and pipe end sections
- Installing new walls for water gauging
- Replacing signage, pavement markings and other related work

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

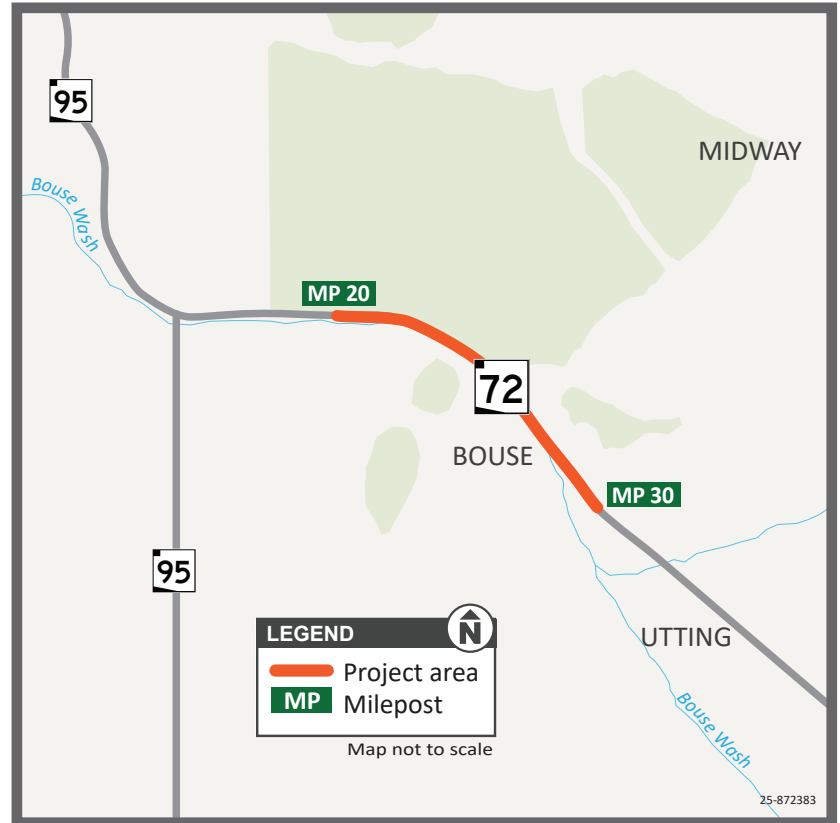
- The project is anticipated to begin fall of 2025 with completion in early winter of 2025.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- To minimize traffic impacts, milling and paving work is tentatively scheduled to occur from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. on weekdays.
- Other related work will take place during the day, which will require lane restrictions. Flagging and pilot vehicle operations will be scheduled as needed. Schedules are subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen situations.
- ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.
