



# Northbound I-17 Off-Ramp at Sonoran Desert Drive Widening Project

## FACT SHEET

### OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Maricopa Association of Governments, is widening the northbound Interstate 17 off-ramp at Sonoran Desert Drive to increase capacity on the ramp and reduce traffic congestion on northbound I-17.

### PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Adding an additional lane to the northbound I-17 off-ramp at Sonoran Desert Drive
- ▶ Constructing a storm drain
- ▶ Installing new overhead signs
- ▶ Restriping the outside lanes of northbound I-17 to accommodate the new ramp configuration

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction is anticipated to start in August 2025 and is expected to take approximately four months to complete.

### WHAT TO EXPECT


- ▶ Lane restrictions will be needed throughout construction but are expected to be minimal.
- ▶ No closures of the off-ramp or northbound I-17 are anticipated.
- ▶ ADOT will provide advance notification of restrictions to email subscribers and on the project webpage.
