



# State Route 87 Payson Street Improvements

## PROJECT FACT SHEET

### OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a street improvement project along State Route 87 between Green Valley Parkway and Crackerjack Road in Payson (mileposts 251-256).

### PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Remove and replace the existing top layer of pavement.
- ▶ Construct Americans with Disabilities Act complaint sidewalk ramps.
- ▶ Reconstruct turnouts and driveways, as needed.
- ▶ Construct and/or reconstruct stormwater improvements.
- ▶ Install and/or reconstruct traffic signals, as needed.
- ▶ Remove and construct new handrail, as needed.
- ▶ Adjust and/or relocate utilities, as needed.
- ▶ Trim and/or remove vegetation.
- ▶ Restore landscaping, as needed.
- ▶ Address erosion control, as needed.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

**All work requiring lane restrictions will be conducted overnight.**

Lane restrictions will be in place from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday nights through Friday mornings. No work is anticipated on weekends or holidays.

*In the event a lane restriction is required during the day, a traffic alert will be issued notifying the public of the upcoming restriction.*

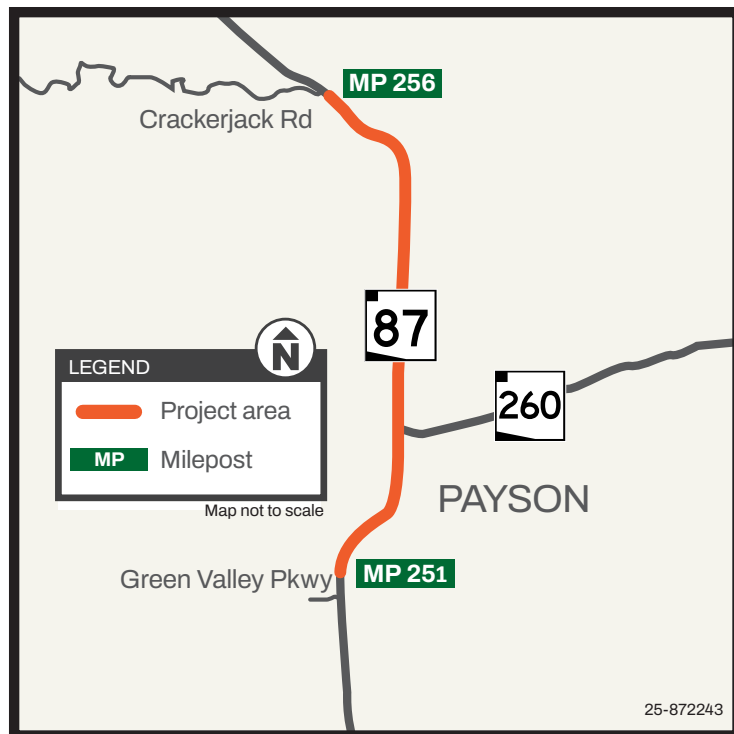
Throughout the paving work, a minimum of one lane in each direction will be maintained. ADOT advises drivers to plan for possible delays while the work is underway.

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled to begin in early August 2025 with sidewalk/ramp work. Repaving SR 87 will begin spring 2026. The project is scheduled to be completed by late 2026.
