



US 93 Vista Royale Improvements

FACT SHEET

September 2025

PROJECT OVERVIEW

ADOT is planning to improve a 3.1-mile segment of US 93 approximately 6 miles northwest of Wickenburg. The project will:

- ▶ Improve the existing US 93 two-lane roadway to a four-lane divided highway, with two new southbound lanes separated by a center median.
- ▶ Construct a new two-way frontage road on the east side of US 93 between Nine Irons Ranch Road and Antelope Creek Road for local traffic circulation.
- ▶ Construct a new two-lane southbound bridge across the BNSF railroad tracks.
- ▶ Construct a new roundabout at Moreton Airpark Road and Nine Irons Ranch Road.
- ▶ Provide accommodations for potential future roundabouts.

PROJECT PURPOSE AND NEED

The project will tie into four-lane sections of US 93 to the north and to the south. The project, which will require right-of-way acquisitions and utility relocations, would:

- ▶ Improve traffic operations on US 93
- ▶ Improve passing opportunities
- ▶ Reduce frequency and severity of crashes

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The planned improvements are currently at 60% design, with construction scheduled for fall 2026.

OTHER UPCOMING US 93 PROJECTS

US 93 WICKENBURG RANCH WAY — SR 89

This project consists of improving US 93 from two to four lanes between Wickenburg Ranch Way and SR 89 and constructing a roundabout at the intersection of US 93 and SR 89. Construction is scheduled to start in fall 2026.

US 93 BIG JIM WASH

This project includes improving US 93 from two lanes to four lanes between mileposts 162 and 166. The Big Jim Wash Bridge near milepost 166 will be replaced and feature a wildlife crossing and wildlife fencing. Construction is anticipated to start in fall 2027.
