Program Overview FTA Section 5307 & 5339

- The Urbanized Area (UZA) Formula Funding (5307) program is allocated to small urban communities (50K-200K Population).
 Communities that are not ready to obligate funds return them to the pool.
- The Bus and Bus Facilities (5339) program is apportioned to the state of Arizona and is divided into Small Urban and Statewide funding. This funding is available through the ADOT competitive pool process to fund capital project(s) (e.g. vehicles, facility construction)



Program Overview Eligibility

- Section 5307 and Section 5339 Small Urban competitive funding pool is limited to existing small urban designated UZAs, and the Direct Recipient must apply.
- Section 5339 Statewide Funding is open to small urban and 5311 rural transit providers.
- There is a limit of <u>one</u> application and three (3) projects per recipient.

NEPA for Facilities Project Readiness

- Applications requesting new bus stops, bus shelters or transit facilities
 - Maps <u>must</u> be provided showing the proposed locations
- Applications requesting capital purchases of vehicles
 - A build sheet <u>must</u> be provided which includes the anticipated cost of the vehicle(s) being requested.



NEPA for Facilities Project Readiness - Construction Projects

- Applications requesting construction projects must provide the following documentation in application:
 - Site selection
 - Environmental justice
 - NEPA documentation


Project Readiness - Construction Projects

- ADOT & FTA Strongly suggest that prior to applying for funding that coordination meetings be held.
 - 5307 Small Urban Applicants coordination meeting should be held with FTA.
 - 5311 Rural Public Transit Applicants of ADOT should hold coordination meetings with ADOT and FTA.



NEPA for Facilities Project Readiness

NEPA is required for facility and construction projects.



Supporting Documentation Financial Readiness

Provide Supporting Documentation demonstrating readiness to proceed on the project.

Supporting documentation must be provided to justify the cost of your project	t. e.g. Build Sheets, Design or Construction Cost	Estimate

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Price increases that exceed the award amount will need to be entirely be covered by the awardee's own funds.



Local Match Financial Readiness

Language change on the local match commitment. Local Match (such as sales tax, property tax, local fund, etc.) being used for the project(s) should be clearly identified.

4. Documented commitment in the form of a resolution or signed letter from highest authorized official to commit Local Match.

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Direct to FTA Supporting Documentation

- Direct Recipients must apply to FTA within 6 months of award and funding should be committed within 12 months.
- funds in TRAMS if previous award given.

Application Evaluation Evaluation Criterion

- State of Good Repair (20%)
- Project Readiness (20%)
- Financial Readiness (20%)
- Agency performance measures (20%)
- Demonstrated good standing (10%)
- Stakeholder support/ involvement (10%)



Construction Projects Evaluation Criteria

- Site Selection and Environmental Justice analysis provided
- Did the applicant discuss the project requirements with ADOT and/or FTA?
- Has the applicant ensured that if design occurred during NEPA that it did not exceed the 30% design mark until NEPA is completed and approved?



Construction Projects Evaluation Criteria Continued

- Has NEPA been completed for the approved site selected with subsequent ADOT & FTA approval
- Was documentation provided explaining any socio-economic impacts on the community surrounding the construction site



Capital Projects Criteria

- For vehicle requests ADOT verifies that a build sheet is provided including the anticipated cost of the vehicle(s) being requested
- For bus shelters, maps must be provided reflecting where any new structures are proposed



5307 & 5339 Grant Application Important Information

- <u>All</u> awardees are required to comply with <u>all</u> Federal program requirements and ADOT's contract where applicable.
- Awardees which are not direct recipients of FTA, will have the award added to their existing ADOT contract and will be paid through the Egrants reimbursement process.
- Direct Recipients will be given a transfer letter to include with their TRAMS application and will apply for funds awarded by ADOT through TRAMS upon notice of award.
- Awardees must able to provide a local match which is generally 20% for capital projects.



5307 & 5339 Grant Application - FAQ

QUESTIONS and COMMENTS	RESPONSES
Are we able to request bus that are nearing the end of their life cycle? For example we have 3 shuttle buses that are over 200,000 miles and by time we would get the funding the buses would be over their useful life cycle.	Recent FTA guidance is that ADOT can only apply for funding for replacement vehicles when that vehicle has reached its useful life or the vehicle will reach its useful life within 1 year of the application to FTA. Staff would need to document how the vehicle will meet its useful life within that 1 year period (ie annual mileage or age of the vehicle). FTA will not allow funding of a replacement vehicle based upon age or mileage of the vehicle at the anticipated time of replacement / delivery of the vehicle.
Does ADOT have a form applicants can fill out for verification of local match funds?	No, Written documentation on agency letterhead signed by your designated signatory is acceptable
Does the review panel consider agencies who guarantee a local match above 20% more favorable?	No, As long as the applicant is able to guarantee they will have the 20% required local match nothing more is required. Exceeding 20% local match does not increase favorability.
Is there a minimum grant request?	Yes, when applying for the funding ADOT will not consider awards of less than \$5,000 as that is generally the FTA threshold for capital purchases.

QUESTIONS and COMMENTS

It was my understanding that NEPA is not required for replacement bus shelters because they are being installed at a current shelter location on an existing concrete pad and no ground disturbance or environmental impact will be sustained?

RESPONSES

NEPA compliance is required on all projects funded with Federal dollars. NEPA is the primary law governing the environmental review process for all federal agencies. NEPA establishes a decision making process that agencies must follow to study the environmental impacts of the proposed projects, both large and small. An environmental determination is required for all projects funded by FTA. Before ADOT can apply to FTA for funding we must complete an environmental review for the project following NEPA and identify in our application the environmental designation of the project. Applicants for ADOT funding must provide sufficient information in the application for ADOT to determine the environmental impacts of the project or the application must provide completed and approved NEPA documents. QUESTIONS and COMMENTS	RESPONSES
Can we use in-kind for our local match	The use of in-kind match is very limited in 5339 funding. 5339 funding does allow for use of in kind for your local match however it can only be used for services donated by a consultant or vendor and therefore is not commonly used.
Can we put five cutaways for our fixed route and the ADA vehicle together or do those have to be two projects?	You can combine up to three vehicles that are the same make, model, and size into one project. If they are not the same make model and size they would be considered a separate project.
Will there be a cure period with changes allowed after the application due date or can we delay submitting the application?	The application is due August 29, 2024 at 3 PM and there are no delays allowed. There is also no cure period or changes allowed after the application submission with the exception of a board resolution that can be submitted via email. Please be thorough in your application preparation and timely in your submission. If for some reason the application does not submit, please contact ADOT prior to the deadline as we can address technical issues.
