2nd Quarter Status Report

With over 240 personnel spread over 25 offices and a multi-million dollar operating budget, Central District functions within the greater Phoenix area, which is the 10th largest and fastest growing metropolitan area in the US. The District covers two counties, 26 incorporated communities - nine of which are among the 10 largest cities in Arizona - and encompasses roughly 5,500 lane-miles of state freeways and highways.

Central District plays a crucial role in the lifecycle of our infrastructure. Beginning in scoping, District construction staff assists in the development of upcoming projects and fully administers the construction oversight on behalf of the State. After construction is complete, District maintenance forces work hard to keep the State's infrastructure at the highest operational capacity.

Central District boasts an exemplary record for accommodating special events like Super Bowls and NCAA Final Four events, all while having the highest traffic volumes in the State. Central District also plays a key role in handling all kinds of extreme weather. This ranges from plowing snow on SR-87 - in partnership with the North Central District - to dealing with the extreme heat and monsoon storms in the summer.

- Completed mill and fill on Grand Ave between MP 127.75 & MP 130
- Completed a total of 15 girder repairs on SR 303L and Camelback Road
- Completed emergency girder repairs on 16th Street and I-17 (Total of 18 girders were repaired)
- Mill and leave plus slab repairs/replacement on EB SR 202L San Tan between MP 41 & MP 38.5 scheduled for November 2025 to cover the 3 dips around Williams Field Road
- Mill and fill on SR 74 and Lake Pleasant Parkway intersection MP 24 scheduled for October 2025
- Mill and fill on SR 238 between MP 41 & MP 42 scheduled spring 2026 and possibly adding a 4-foot shoulder to this section
- Mill and fill on I-17 frontage road and Camelback Road is scheduled for November 2025
- A slab jack project on 51st Avenue and Grand Avenue is scheduled in October 2025
- A mill and fill project is scheduled for October 2025 on SR 202L San Tan to I-10 WB transition ramp
