

















## The Role of a Byway Leader in Scenic Byway Quality Protection

- Know a route's designation and what it means.
- Understand that signage is important and is also a major maintenance item.
- Think about route conditions and what messages are conveyed to the travelling public about safety and access.
- Have a plan to address and mitigate solid waste.
- Expect graffiti and have a plan to address it.
- Be mindful of the types and colors of guardrail present on the route.
- Know that caring and advocacy will ensure a byway doesn't get left behind.
- Communicate throughout the life cycle of any construction project.
- Strategize how to improve facilities where needed.
- Assume an "all hands on deck" approach to tackle vegetation and maintenance issues.
