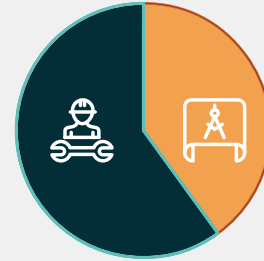

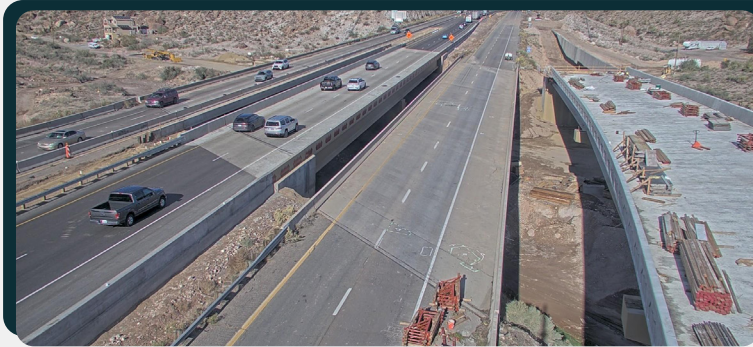
#### RENDERINGS TO REALITY

#### Current Progress:

- Controlled rock blasting on I-40.
- Sound wall installation.
- Bridge girder placement over I-40 coming soon.
- Work on south-to-east flyover bridge from southbound to US 93 to eastbound I-40.





Construction of the new south-to-east flyover bridge along I-40 is progressing.



Work on the south-to-east flyover bridge deck along I-40 continues.

## Nearby Project Updates:

### I-40 Holy Moses Wash to Rattlesnake Wash

In spring 2026, work will resume to remove and replace the worn pavement along an 11-mile section of I-40 between Holy Moses Wash and Rattlesnake Wash in Kingman (mileposts 47-58).

### I-40 Rancho Santa Fe Traffic Interchange

Construction started in December 2024. The interchange in east Kingman is currently 40% complete and is scheduled to be finished in mid-2026.

### US 93 Sanctuary Road to I-40

A roadway improvement project is scheduled to start in mid-January 2026 along a 23-mile section of US 93 between Chloride and Kingman (mileposts 48-71). The project includes replacing the worn pavement on the roadway, shoulders and median crossover.

## Holiday Break

There will be no construction activities between Dec. 24, 2025 and Jan. 4, 2026 in observance of the Christmas and New Year's holidays. There will be no additional restrictions or closures during that time frame.
