### **MODULE 6 - ROAD PORTAL AND MAINTENANCE**

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#### **RECORD DRAWINGS/REPOSITORY OF ONLINE ARCHIVED DOCUMENTS (ROAD) PORTAL:**

- Record Drawings are formally known as As-Builts and are a full set of As-Bid engineering plans that show all of the field changes that occurred during construction.
- The Record Drawings note field observations, design changes and red line corrections and are approved by the Resident Engineer.
- Record Drawings can be submitted via ADOT Sharefile, by an FTP site and via email.
- The ROAD Portal houses state and local projects administered by ADOT.

#### **CENTRAL MAINTENANCE:**

- Central District serves two counties, 27 incorporated communities, 4.8 million resident population, has 9 of the 10 largest cities in Arizona, 2016 maintenance lane miles and 11 construction and 15 maintenance units (250 people).
- The District maintains the roadway, roadside, structures and drainage systems. They react to weather hazards, civil disturbances, right of way, planning and staging of large events, and permitting for events.

#### **RURAL MAINTENANCE:**

- Southeast District serves portions of 6 counties, 14 incorporated communities, resident population of 200,000, highest route SR 366/lowest SR88, 18 routes for 1,028 lane miles and 3 construction and 7 maintenance units.
- The largest city in the district is Douglas at 17,000 people. The smallest is Winkelman with 310.
- Southeast District coordinates and responds to routine maintenance and traffic incidents. Incidents include fires and floods.
