



Cesar Chavez Boulevard Roadway Improvements: State Route 195 to US 95

PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The City of San Luis, in coordination with the Arizona Department of Transportation began a project to reconstruct 5 miles of Cesar Chavez Boulevard between Escondido Street and Avenue E.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Reconstructing the roadway along Cesar Chavez Boulevard to a four lane divided roadway
- ▶ Construct drainage facilities
- ▶ Install asphaltic concrete, signage
- ▶ Install pavement marking, signals, lighting, and other related work
- ▶ Construction of an one-lane roundabout at the intersection of Cesar Chavez Boulevard and Escondido Street/San Luis Plaza Drive.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- ▶ Construction will begin spring 2026 and is expected to be completed early spring 2028.

WHAT TO EXPECT

ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.
