



SR 89A Guardrail Replacement

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a guardrail replacement project along State Route 89A in Oak Creek Canyon between Pine Flat Campground and Oak Creek Vista (mileposts 387-390).

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Remove existing guardrail
- ▶ Install new guardrail
- ▶ Install concrete barrier
- ▶ Reconstruct damaged curb and gutter, as needed
- ▶ Seeding and erosion control measures, as needed
- ▶ Tree removal, as needed
- ▶ Erosion control measures

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The project, which is approximately 13 miles north of Sedona, is expected to be under construction in spring 2026 and anticipated for completion by fall 2026.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Work will typically take place from 6 a.m to 6 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays, and Fridays until noon.

- ▶ SR 89A will be reduced to one lane only in the project area with alternating north- and southbound travel.
- ▶ Flaggers and a pilot car will guide drivers through the work zone.
- ▶ There will be a 12-foot width restriction.
- ▶ Tour buses will use I-17 while work is underway.

When needed, the restrictions will remain in place around the clock, 24/7. When the restrictions are continuous, temporary traffic signals will be in operation during non-working hours for traffic control.

ADOT advises drivers to plan for delays while the work is underway.
